

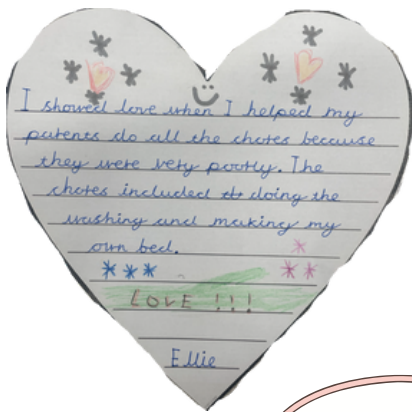
This half-term, our school value has been **LOVE**.

How have we shown **Love** this halfterm?



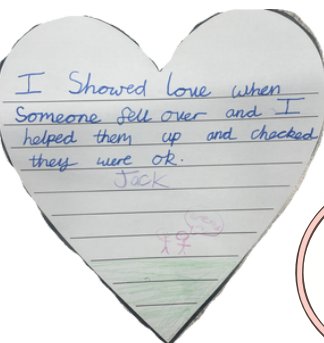
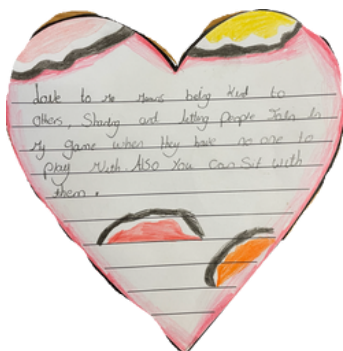
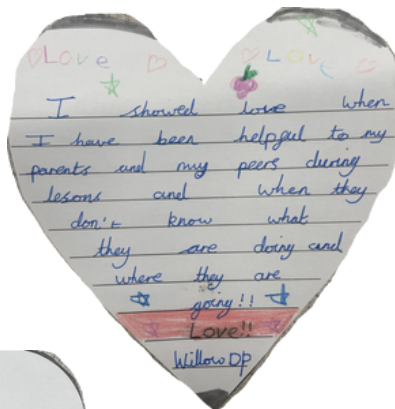
The Flourishing Voices Council have shown Love by supporting Samaritans Purse, Children in Need, and giving an assembly on God's love at Christmastime.
