KS1- 9:30- 10:45am- sports activities

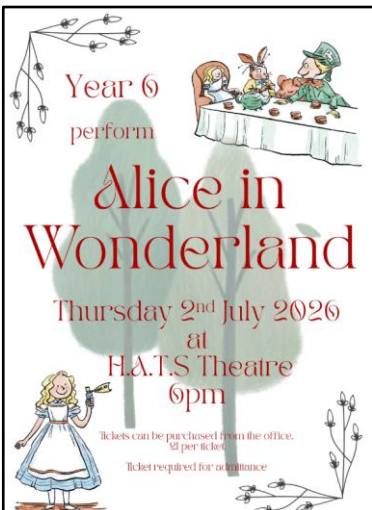
