St Peter's Fair – Wednesday 9th July

On Wednesday 9th July, children in Years 1–6 will be taking part in Singing in the Square at 11:30am. Following their performance, they will walk to watch the Pretty Maid procession at 11:50am before returning to school for lunch.

As the children will be arriving back later than usual, we will be offering a picnic-style lunch on this day. The lunch options, which can be selected via ParentMail, are:

- Sausage half baguette
- Cheese and onion lattice
- Cheese sandwich

School will remain open as normal throughout the day (and until 6:00pm for those attending after-school provision).

If your child is participating in one of the town's events during the morning, please inform the school office, providing details of the activity in which they are involved. Their absence will then be authorised.

In addition, parents may choose to collect their child at 1:30pm. The school gates will open at this time for collections. Please collect your child from their classroom door as you would normally, and their teacher will record their departure. The gates will then reopen at the usual time of 3:15pm for end-of-day collection. To minimise disruption to teaching and learning, we kindly ask that children are not collected at other times during the afternoon unless absolutely necessary. If you do need to collect your child between these 2 times, please report to the school office so that they can be signed out correctly.

Summer Conert – Thursday 8th July

When returning to school for the Summer Concert, please bring your child to their classroom door between **4:45pm and 4:55pm**.

After dropping off your child, please make your way to the top playground, where seating areas will be clearly marked. Families are encouraged to bring picnic



blankets, camping chairs or other suitable outdoor seating to ensure they are comfortable during the performance.

Children should attend in their full school uniform.

The concert is expected to last for approximately one hour. During the event, FOHPS will be providing refreshments, which will be available to purchase. We look forward to welcoming you for what promises to be a wonderful evening of music and celebration – fingers crossed it remains dry!

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2

If your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, you do not need to collect them at the end of the school day before the disco. If they are changing clothes for the disco, please send these into school in a named bag.

Children will remain with their class teacher after school, change if required, and then be escorted to the disco and signed in. Please collect your child from outside their classroom at 4:30pm when the disco finishes.

Years 3, 4, 5 and 6

Children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 should be collected as normal at the end of the school day.

When returning for the disco, please wait by the double doors at the bottom of the ramp, next to the bike storage area.

Children who attend After School Club until 6:00pm will be taken to the disco and signed in at 4:45pm.

At the end of the disco:

- Years 3, 4 and 5 should be collected from outside their classroom door.
- Year 6 pupils should be collected from the school hall at 6:15pm.

Please note that children do not have permission to walk home unaccompanied at this time of day, so arrangements must be made for an adult to collect them.

No mobile phones please – if your child needs their phone for after the disco, these can be handed in at the ticket desk when signing in and will be returned when they head home.
